Group of Colorado Legislators Refuse to Certify 2024 Election Results

Six Republican state representatives have refused to certify the 2024 Colorado general election results. Their objection is based on the discovered posting of BIOS voting system equipment passwords on the Colorado Secretary of State's general public website just prior to the 2024 general election.

BIOS passwords allow access to the electronic voting system equipment software used throughout Colorado.

Anyone with access to the voting systems had the ability to alter the trusted build of those systems without leaving any signs of tampering with the software.

The passwords were posted – either intentionally or unintentionally – from September 2024 to October 24, 2024. The entire State of Colorado electronic voting system network was exposed to anyone in possession of the passwords for a minimum of at least two months.

The password enables anyone access to the trusted build of the voting system equipment in 63 of Colorado's 64 counties.

This breach of proprietary electronic voting system equipment **was not originally disclosed** by the office of the Secretary of State. At a very minimum this breach raises a serious question about the integrity of the Colorado electronic voting system equipment and software and the accuracy of the results of the general election in Colorado.

The Silence Dogood Letters

Silence Dogood was the pen name used by Benjamin Franklin to get his work published in the New-England Courant, a newspaper founded and published by his brother. This was after Benjamin Franklin was denied several times when he tried to publish letters under his own name in the Courant. The 14 Mrs. Silence Dogood letters were first printed in 1722. As a young boy, Franklin worked as an apprentice in his older brother's printing shop in Boston, where The New-England Courant was published and printed. Franklin never got anything he wrote published, so, at age 16, he created the persona of a middle-aged widow named Silence Dogood.

Silence Dogood template is a way of expressing yourself without giving you real name with a controversial opinion. Hence, the Silence Dogood letters. ●

Liberate Colorado: Next Steps

This past September, a survey was taken to determine the level of interest by RSF members to engage in the effort to 'Liberate Colorado' (Make Colorado Red Again) using Gordon Klingenschmitt's book 'How to Liberate the World'.

The majority of responses were 'undecided' due to members indicating a lack of knowledge about the contents of the book.

To close the knowledge gap, the author was invited to present a four-part series describing the contents of the book to RSF members. Now armed with that knowledge, a follow-on survey is currently being conducted (see step 7 n adjacent column) to re-evaluate the level of interest by RSF members to 'Liberate Colorado'.

Regardless of the results of the survey, the next step (8) is to form a committee dedicated exclusively to 'Liberate Colorado'.

Forming a committee to 'Liberate Colorado' is not automatic. A motion must be made and seconded to open the floor for a vote by RSF members for permission to proceed with forming the committee.

If the motion fails, the effort to 'Liberate Colorado' is likely ended. If the motion passes, the next step is to solicit members for the committee to 'Liberate Colorado'.

Once committee members are determined, they must elect a representative to report status to the RSF team.

Next, it is highly recommended the committee craft a charter describing purpose – where it is going, how it is going to get there, and present it to the RSF for approval.
